Self Study Program NOW AVAILABLE!

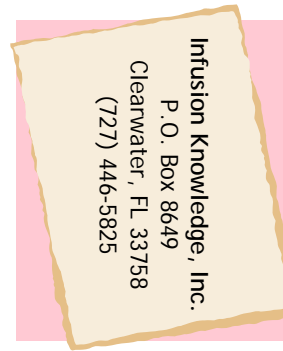
